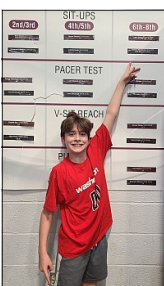
Multiple students broke fitness records this week. Congrats to the following middle school students:

FAST Round 3

The third round of the FAST Tuition Assistance online application process for school year 2022-2023 is now open.

The deadline for completing the FAST online application for this round is Wednesday, July 6, and the deadline for submitting all supporting documentation to FAST is Monday, July 18. Types of documentation requested include, but are not limited to, your most recent federal and state tax returns and W-2s. Cost of the application is \$48 per family. Students from Mr. Focht's US History 1 learned about the hardships experienced by WW1 soldiers during the war. Mr. Focht showed different authentic uniform items/artifacts, and also discussed what the soldiers did during their free time. The items included a US Army medic uniform, a German M16-18 "stahlhelm" helmet, and a piece of trench art. To make money, soldiers would use tools to make artillery shells into elaborate pieces of art, such as vases. With care, the students had the opportunity to handle some of the artifacts.
