## Tuition Assistance - Round 2

The second round of the FAST Tuition Assistance online application process for school year 2022-2023 is now open. The deadline for completing the FAST online application for this round is Wednesday, May 4, and the deadline for submitting all supporting documentation to FAST is Monday, May 16. include, but are not limited to, your most recent federal and state tax returns and W-2s. Cost of the application is \$48 per family. Orders are DUE by April 22nd.



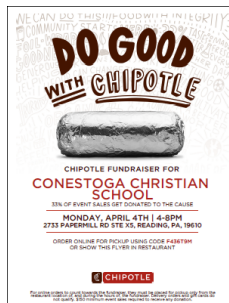
## Our Youngest Fishermen
