1. **Online** at the following links:

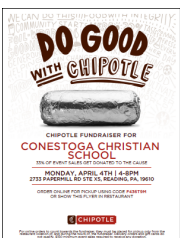

Fourth and Fifth grade students are "Walking like Egyptians" this week as they have been **enjoying Adventure Days and their study of Ancient Egypt**. They have researched, learned, collaborated, written, created, and read about all things Ancient Egypt throughout the week.

Students connected the Israelites' exodus from Egypt with God's hand of protection upon His people.
