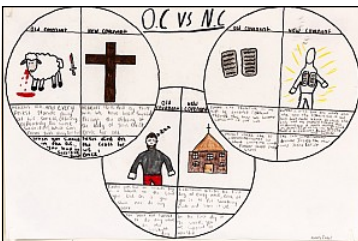
Congratulations!

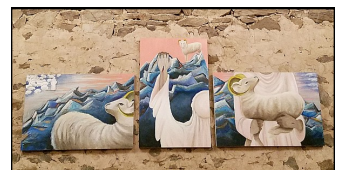
